## Video: Creative Mind Niamh Barry Talks About Her Stunning New Lighting Creations

Fore more than three decades, Irish designer Niamh Barry has been conjuring gravity-defying light sculptures that re-create the warm, golden glow of fire. Now <u>Barry</u>, who was named one of *Galerie*'s 2021 <u>Creative Minds</u>, is unveiling a new series of fixtures at Maison Gerard that

represent an evolution of her earlier works, among them *Vessel Scape*, a 30-foot-long work inspired by a Bronze-age artifact called the Broighter boat, made for the Central Bank of Ireland, and *Underneath* that debuted at an exhibition in Milan.
